POSITION: Development Writer

SUMMARY: This position will broadly support the vision, mission, goals, and values of PPRM as a key member of the Organizational Giving and Development Teams. Organizational Giving is a subset of PPRM’s fundraising team, responsible for proposal writing, grant management, stewardship, and reporting to foundations, corporations, and government funders so as to build a strong financial base for PPRM’s future. This position is primarily focused on writing proposals and reports for organizational donors (foundations, associations, businesses, and government), and also includes creating or revising proposals and reports for individual donors, as well as creating other written material.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Prepare strong, thorough proposals to foundations, associations, corporations, municipal governments, and individuals to support PPRM programs and meet agency fundraising goals.
- Prepare strong, thorough templates on funding opportunities that can be used in proposals, white papers, and other communications.
- Coordinate as needed with PPRM program staff (including C4, medical services, public affairs and education) and finance departments during grant writing and reporting process
- Prepare reports demonstrating impact, successes and challenges for funders as required by grant contracts and donor stewardship.

- ❑ Work with the Organizational Giving team to coordinate grant schedule for writing proposals, reports, and other communications to foundations.
- ❑ Contribute to donor-centered publications, such as the quarterly newsletter, as needed.
- ❑ Help to maintain Raiser's Edge database to ensure timely reports and proposals are submitted.
- ❑ Track statistics relevant to proposals/submissions.
- ❑ Maintain grant reporting and tracking records in database and paper files
- ❑ Support the team environment with ideas and skills as required by team direction including, but not limited to, editing/proofreading other written materials as appropriate.
- ❑ Participate in abortion services (participation can include referrals, information, education, counseling, performing, scheduling, etc.)
- ❑ Other duties as required.
